Paulistanos love to...

– Ask for a “*média com pão na chapa*” (coffee with milk and French bread with butter) at the bakery in the morning. Try it!

- Ask for draft and pasty in bars.
- Ride bikes in lanes or jog at Minhocão on Sundays.

- Go to the Municipal Market and eat a sandwich with almost a pound of bologna.
- Ask for a “*pingado*” (coffee with a little milk) at the bakery at any time of the day.
- Eat ham sandwich after a soccer match in front of the stadium.
- Eat feijoada on Wednesdays and Saturdays.
- Eat hotdog or go to a 24-hour bakery after parties.

- We have the greatest cultural offer in South America, with 110 museums, 40 cultural centers, 80 libraries, 280 cinemas and 160 theaters.
- We are the city with the greatest offer of hotels in South America, with 42 thousand rooms in 410 hotels.

- We are one of the world's gastronomic capitals, with 12.5 restaurants serving 52 types of cuisine. We have the world's 6th best restaurant, DOM.
- We are the greatest health tourism destination in Brazil – including foreigners seeking for good and more affordable physicians.
- We love pizza so much that we have created the Pizza Day. It is easy to find a delivery at the city corners.
- We have about 60 streets of thematic commerce, from electronic devices to chandeliers.

- Even being a large metropolis, we conserve indigenous villages, Environmental Preservation Areas in the south end of the city, which can be visited.
